## Endangered species around the world

Can you imagine a world without whales, elephants, polar bears, or gorillas?

1  There are about 5,000 endangered animal species. Some scientists believe that at least one species disappears completely every day.

There are many reasons why some animals become endangered species. Most of them are due to human behaviour. Every species needs its own natural place to live, but pollution, farming and building are destroying these areas.
